- *He noted the focus of meeting would be to review the Induction Guidelines which were last evaluated in November 2015 in preparation for the 2016 Induction.*
- The document "2016 Induction Guidelines Springwater Sports Heritage Hall of Fame" would be the basis of the analysis for much of the discussion.

#### 3. 2016 Induction Guidelines Review

• The following reflects the review of the 2016 Induction Guidelines and the recommendations for the Board

#### Section A: Inductees 1. Classifications a. Athlete

- Possible confusion over the sports that are recognized was discussed
  - 2016 Wording:
    - "Individuals who have excelled on the regional, provincial, national and/or international sports scene over an extended period of time."
  - o Revised
    - "Individuals who have excelled in a recognized sport on the regional, provincial, national and/or international sports scene over an extended period of time."

- Currently the Induction Guidelines reflect what is expected i.e.
   "Builders shall include league or team officials, referees, umpires, sponsors, executives, trainers and coaches etc. who's work for sports in Springwater Township, regionally, provincially, nationally or internationally over an extended period of time has been outstanding."
- The following Constitutional wording is somewhat geographically restrictive <u>"Builders inducted will have demonstrated they were successful in creating a</u> <u>climate which successfully benefitted athletes and athletics in the Township of</u> <u>Springwater"</u>
- Committee recommends the wording of the Constitution be amended to reflect the broader intent of the Induction Guidelines

# <u>ACTION</u>: Consistent with amendment procedures the Induction Committee will ask the Board to put forward the following proposed amendment at the next Board Meeting

that the last sentence, paragraph 2, page 3 of the Springwater Constitution be amended to read: "Builders inducted will have demonstrated they were successful in creating a climate which significantly benefitted athletes and athletics"
