3.1. Weighted Criteria and Forms

3.1.1. 2017,2,13 Action

"ACTION: Trish and Darrin will develop a working copy of a 'weighted criteria' for each category. Hopefully, this can be shared with all Committee members ASAP. Following feedback and approval, a proposed Nomination Form will be written that will assist nominators in supplying corresponding supporting data for their nominee. This is to be completed for the next Induction meeting Scheduled for May 15, 2017"

- **3.1.2.** Darrin presented the group with a working copy of their efforts towards developing a more detailed and weighted criteria for the initial evaluation of potential SSHHoF nominations. (See APPENDIX A)
 - Discussion
 - Positive Highlights expressed:
 - good effort to provide evaluators with a more detailed criteria
 - setting a points-threshold consideration was agreed to
 - those meeting that points threshold would go on to Parte 2 of the selection process where Inductee numbers would be determined and a ranking process put in place to make final Inductee selections.

- this published criteria would assist nominators in adequately filling in their nomination forms
- Concerns expressed:
 - Re Section 1. Level of Competition and Achievement- weighting 50%. It was suggested keeping the 50% level but change subsection d) and e) to 10% each
 - Re Section 2. Difficulty in Achieving Success- weighting 20%. More emphasis on Years to obtain success, Obstacles and Competition
 - Re Section 3. Dedication over Time- weighting 15%. This section seemed to pose problems for Team nomination
 - Re Section 4. Personal Characteristics- weighting 15%. Again this section had concerns re a Team evaluation
- Despite the effort to make one Criteria List relevant to all three categories (Athletes, Builders, and Teams)-it was felt that it would be advisable to develop a Criteria List for each category.

<u>ACTION:</u> Darrin, Larry and Trish will tailor these four sections to each category and in the process produce nomination forms for Athletes, Builders and Teams. Induction Committee approval of the criteria and forms needs to be completed prior to mid-September for presentation at the fall Board meeting.

3.2. Critical Path

- Nomination materials need to be on the website by mid-October
- It was felt that the Nomination deadline should be moved back and more time for the evaluation and selection process given.
- Initial proposed changes discussed and added (see APPENDIX B).

APPENDIX A

Criteria for Selecting Nominations to the SSHHoF.

This Criteria could be used for Athletes and Builders and Teams.

- 1. Level of Competition and Achievement
 - a) Success at the local level (Springwater) 10pts
 - b) Success at the Provincial level 10pts
 - c) Success at the National level 10pts
 - d) Success a the world or professional level 15pts
 - e) Were any records set, individual statistics or awards achieved 5pts

A total of 50 pts would be awarded under this section for an athlete, builder or team that had met any of this criteria.

- 2. Difficulty in Achieving Success
 - a) How difficult was it for the athlete, builder or team to achieve their success.
 - b) What were the different levels that the athlete, builder or team had to go through to achieve their successes.

Would award up to 20 pts toward their difficulty.

- 3. Dedication over Time
 - a) Was the athlete, builder or team accomplishments over a period of time or a particular season.

Would award up to 15 pts toward their dedication.

- 4. Personal Characteristics
 - a) Factors to consider are leadership, integrity, sportsmanship, and community involvement.

Would award up to 15 pts toward personal characteristics.

There is a total of 100pts that a nomination can achieve. A nomination would need at least 60 pts to be considered for the induction.
